

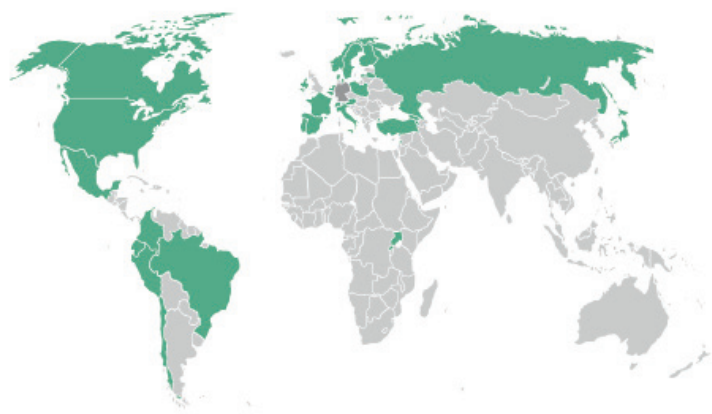


## PARTNER UNIVERSITIES
